

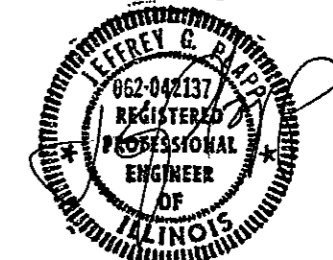

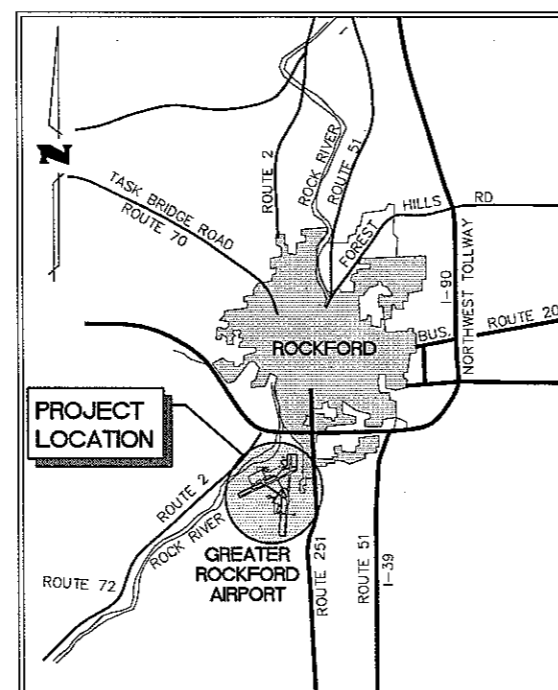

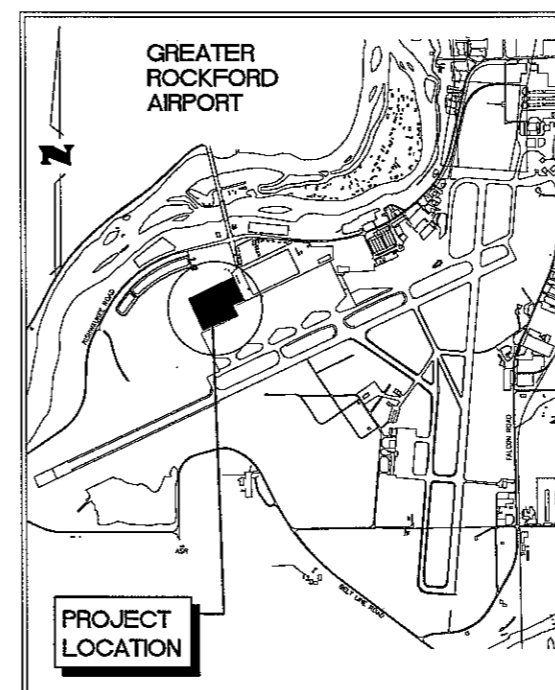

Sealed proposals will be received by the Greater Rockford Airport Authority at 60 Airport Drive, Rockford, Illinois 61109 until 9:45 A.M. local time on Monday, May 9, 2005 for the construction of EXPAND NORTHWEST QUADRANT AIR CARGO APRON AND ASSOCIATED SITEWORK – CONTRACT 1 (GRADING) at which time bids will be publicly opened and read at the Airport Authority Offices, 1st Floor Conference Room, 60 Airport Drive, Rockford, Illinois 61109. Faxed proposals will **not** be accepted.

The Proposal will consist of the first phase of work associated with the expansion of the northwest quadrant air cargo apron and associated site improvements at the Northwest Chicagoland International Airport **at ROCKFORD (RFD)**. Work will include site grading, bituminous paving, erosion control, temporary and permanent fencing and other appurtenant work

Instructions to Bidders, form of proposals, plans, specifications and form of agreement for this work may be examined at the office of Crawford, Murphy & Tilly, Inc., 2 Airport Circle, Rockford, Illinois 61109 and the office of the Greater Rockford Airport, 60 Airport Drive, Rockford, Illinois 61109. Copies may **only** be obtained from the office of Greater Rockford Airport, 60 Airport Drive, Rockford, Illinois 61109, upon payment of Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each set, which shall be **NON-REFUNDABLE**.

Each prospective bidder must be reputable with satisfactory history of providing similar construction as required by the plans and specifications. All bidders shall be pre-qualified by the Illinois Department of Transportation. If requested the prospective bidder shall satisfy the Greater Rockford Airport Authority that experience and financial stability exists. Further, each prospective bidder must demonstrate their ability to satisfactorily complete the project within

Additional information may be requested after the receipt of bids to further determine that a contemplated awardee is fully qualified to receive the award. Such statements and information shall be furnished immediately upon request.

A bid bond, cashier's check, or a certified check made payable to the order of the Greater Rockford Airport Authority, in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the total bid including all additive alternates, must be deposited by each bidder with his bid as guarantee that in case the contract is awarded to him, he will within fifteen (15) days thereafter, upon receipt of written notice of award, execute such contract and furnish a satisfactory performance bond. Upon failure to do so, he shall forfeit the deposit as liquidated damages and acceptance of the bid will be contingent upon the fulfillment of this requirement by the bidder.

The checks or bid bonds of all, except the three (3) lowest responsible bidders, will be returned within ten (10) days after the bids are opened and read. The remaining checks or bid bonds will be refunded as soon as the contract and bond have been properly executed and approved.

The successful bidder, as determined by the Owner, will be required to agree that no less than the prevailing rate of wages will be paid to all workmen, laborers, and mechanics performing their work under this contract.

All proposals must be made on forms furnished within this set of Contract Documents.

The successful bidder will be required to furnish performance and payment bonds satisfactory to the owner in the amount of the contract.

The Owner reserves the right to waive or not to waive any irregularities in the bids and to reject any or all bids and to determine which is the lowest and best bid or combination of bids for the improvements.
